#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

The Department of Health and Human Services will experience General Fund savings estimated to be \$2,433,062 in fiscal year 2014-15 due to the elimination of MaineCare reimbursement for buprenorphine and naloxone combination drugs and methadone for the treatment of addiction to opioids.
