Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill increases, beginning January 1, 2015, fees on certificates for watercraft operation on inland waters by \$5 (from \$10 to \$15) and lake and river protection stickers for nonresident personal watercraft, motorboats and seaplanes by \$5 (from \$20 to \$25). The Invasive Aquatic Plant and Nuisance Species Fund within the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is estimated to receive \$246,650 in fiscal year 2014-15 and \$517,930 in subsequent fiscal years. This bill provides an allocation to the DEP of \$246,650 in fiscal year 2014-15 for inspecting, eradicating and containing invasive aquatic plants and nuisance species.
