## **Preliminary Fiscal Impact Statement**

Minor savings - General Fund Minor revenue impact - General Fund Minor revenue increase - Other Special Revenue Funds

### **Correctional and Judicial Impact Statements**

Eliminates Class D and Class E crimes and civil violations. A reduction in fines will decrease General Fund revenue by minor amounts.

#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

This legislation lowers from 21 to 18 the age at which people may carry a concealed handgun. This provision could increase General Fund and Other Special Revenue Funds revenue by minor amounts for those individuals under 21 and at least 18 requiring a permit for reciprocity with other states. No change to the budget is required.
