Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill creates a sales tax exemption for nonprofit career and technical student organizations and would result in a loss of General Fund and Local Government Fund revenue of \$1,372 and \$28, respectively, in fiscal year 2017-18 and \$2,019 and \$41, respectively, in fiscal year 2018-19. The Department of Administrative and Financial Services will require a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$2,500 in fiscal year 2017-18 for programming costs.
