## **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

The Educational Opportunity Tax Credit Marketing program within the Finance Authority of Maine will require ongoing General Fund appropriations totaling \$100,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2017-18 to support the Job Creation Through Educational Opportunity Program. Of this amount, \$70,000 per year is provided for one liaison position to assist Maine residents with issues associated with participating in the program. The remaining \$30,000 per year is for increasing the funding for the marketing of the program from \$20,000 per year to \$50,000 per year.
