#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$213,010 in fiscal year 2019-20 and \$214,074 in fiscal year 2020-21 for shared decision-making counseling and annual screening for lung cancer for MaineCare recipients who meet the eligibility criteria recommended by the United States Preventive Services Task Force. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are also included for the FMAP match.
