Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill provides a sales tax exemption to certain nonprofit charitable organizations and would result in a reduction in General Fund revenue of \$133,000 in fiscal year 2019-20 and \$199,500 in fiscal year 2020-21. It would also result in a reduction in Local Government Fund revenue of \$7,000 in fiscal year 2019-20 and \$10,500 in fiscal year 2020-21. The Department of Administrative and Financial Services would require a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$15,000 in fiscal year 2019-20 for programming costs related to creating a sales tax exemption certificate.
