Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$1,169,412 in fiscal year 2019-20 and \$4,688,286 in fiscal year 2020-21 to amend its rules governing MaineCare reimbursement for targeted case management services to provide an increase reflecting cost increases from 2010 to 2019. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are also included for the FMAP match.
