Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment removes General Fund appropriations in fiscal years 2021-22 and 2022-23 of \$43,875 and \$58,500, respectively, to the Department of Public Safety (DPS). It also removes Highway Fund allocations in fiscal years 2021-22 and 2022-23 of \$103,881 and \$46,196, respectively, to the DPS. As amended, the bill still includes General Fund appropriations to the DPS of \$136,500 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$22,750 in fiscal year 2022-23.

The amendment also removes General Fund appropriations to the Office of the Attorney General of \$81,483 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$84,090 in fiscal year 2022-23.
