#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

The bill provides a sales tax exemption for certain items used to secure firearms and would result in a reduction in General Fund revenue of \$42,350 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$85,662 in fiscal year 2022-23. It would also result in a reduction in Local Government Fund revenue of \$1,650 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$3,338 in fiscal year 2022-23.
