Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations and Highway Fund allocations of \$42,500 and \$17,500, respectively, beginning in fiscal year 2023-24 to reimburse authorized handlers of retired law enforcement dogs for health care expenses paid by the handlers up to \$5,000 per calendar year. The bill also includes appropriations of \$15,000 to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife beginning in fiscal year 2023-24 to reimburse authorized handlers of retired search and rescue dogs for healthcare expenses. Finally, the bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Corrections of \$20,000 beginning in fiscal year 2023-24 for these health care expenses.
