### Correctional and Judicial Impact Statements

This bill changes a Class D crime to a civil violation. A reduction in fine revenue will decrease General Fund and dedicated revenue by minor amounts.

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes ongoing General Fund appropriations to the Judicial Department of \$5,000 per year to pay reasonable costs and expenses of court-appointed attorneys to represent indigent persons charged with engaging in unauthorized paramilitary training and related administrative costs.
