1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §4320-K is enacted to read:
3	§4320-K. Coverage for marijuana for medical use
4 5 6	A carrier offering a health plan in this State shall provide coverage for marijuana for medical use for an enrollee who has received certification for the medical use or marijuana from a medical provider under Title 22, section 2423-B.
7	SUMMARY
8 9 10	This bill requires health insurance carriers to provide coverage for marijuana for medical use for a health plan enrollee who has received certification for the medical use of marijuana from an authorized medical provider.
