Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §1215, as amended by PL 2015, c. 267, Pt. PPP, §1, is further amended to read:

§1215. Mileage and compensation of jurors

A juror is entitled to paid mileage at the rate of 15ϕ per mile for travel expenses from the juror's residence to the place of holding court and return, except that, beginning July 1, 2016, a juror is entitled to paid mileage at the rate established in Title 5, section 8. A juror is entitled to compensation at the rate of \$15 \underset{940} for each day of required attendance at sessions of the court.

10 SUMMARY

This bill increases a juror's daily compensation rate from \$15 to \$40.
