1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11205, sub-§1,</b> as affected by PL 2003, c. 614, §9 and amended by c. 655, Pt. B, §137 and affected by §422, is further amended to read:
4	1. Prohibition. A person may not:
5	A. Hunt wild animals or wild birds on Sunday; or
6	A-1. Hunt wild birds on Sunday with any firearm other than a shotgun; or
7 8	B. Possess any wild animal or wild bird taken in violation of paragraph A or A-1 except as otherwise provided in this Part.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill allows licensed hunters to hunt wild birds on Sundays with a shotgun.
