1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. Boundary line between the Town of Harpswell and the Town of**
3 **Brunswick.** The common boundary of the Town of Harpswell, County of Cumberland
4 and the Town of Brunswick, County of Cumberland is that certain boundary created and
5 described in Province of Massachusetts Bay, Province Laws 1738-39, Chapter 28,
6 enacted January 26, 1738, described as follows: beginning at the mouth of the
7 Androscoggin River to run by the water-side, south-westerly, to the south-west point of a
8 place called the new meadows; thence, to strike across the cove, upon a course north-
9 north-west, till it meets and intersects the upper end of Merryconeeg neck, four rods
10 above the narrows of said neck, commonly called the carrying-place; thence to run along
11 the shore to a neck of land called Mare Point, and a mile and a quarter down said neck.

12 **Sec. 2. P&SL 1997, c. 80** is repealed.

13 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill restores the historical boundary line between the Town of Harpswell and the
15 Town of Brunswick.
