An Act To Authorize 3-day All-terrain Vehicle Registration Reciprocity with the Provinces of New Brunswick and Quebec

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §13155, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:
3 4 5	2-A. Reciprocity. The commissioner may allow a nonresident to operate in this State an ATV that is not registered in this State during one 3-consecutive-day period, 2 days of which are weekend days, annually if:
6 7	A. The nonresident's ATV has a valid registration from the Canadian province of New Brunswick or Quebec; and
8 9 10	B. The nonresident's province of residency allows an ATV registered in Maine to be operated in that province for a period of time of at least 3 consecutive days without being registered in that province.
11 12	This subsection may not be construed to authorize the operation of an ATV in a manner contrary to this chapter except as provided in this subsection.
13	Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2018.
14	SUMMARY
15 16	This bill establishes, beginning July 1, 2018, a 3-day all-terrain vehicle registration reciprocity with the Canadian provinces of New Brunswick and Quebec.
