Sec. 1. Rules limiting taking of smelts from coastal waters prohibited; study. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Marine Resources may not adopt or enforce rules that limit the quantity of smelts a person may take from the coastal waters of the State before a study of the smelt population in the State's coastal waters is conducted by the Department of Marine Resources and presented to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over marine resources matters.

7 SUMMARY

This resolve prohibits the Commissioner of Marine Resources from adopting or enforcing a limit on the quantity of smelts a person may take from the coastal waters before the Department of Marine Resources conducts a study of the smelt population in the State's coastal waters and presents its findings to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over marine resources matters.
