1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	CONCEPT DRAFT
3	SUMMARY
4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5	This bill proposes to provide a means to offset the costs incurred by a person with a
6	disability who modifies a residence, such as by installing ramps or stairlifts, widening
7	entryways or remodeling, to make it more accessible for that person. The offset could be
8	in the form of an income tax credit or an exemption from property taxes.
