2 Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13406, as enacted by PL 2005, c. 635, §6, is amended to 3 read:

4 §13406. Minimum salaries

5 Each school administrative unit shall establish a minimum salary of \$30,000 for 6 certified teachers for the school year starting after June 30, 2007 and in each subsequent 7 school year <u>until the school year ending June 30, 2020</u>.

Beginning with the school year starting after June 30, 2020, each school
administrative unit shall establish a minimum salary of \$50,000 for certified teachers for
the school year.

11 SUMMARY

12 This bill requires that the minimum salary of certified teachers in public schools be 13 established at \$50,000 for the school year starting after June 30, 2020.
