7	SUMMARY
8	This amendment is the minority report of the committee. It prohibits a funeral
9	director or practitioner of funeral service from cremating abandoned remains or an
0	abandoned dead body if the funeral director or practitioner of funeral service has
1	knowledge that cremation conflicts with the deceased person's religious tenets and
2	practices.
