1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §682, sub-§18, as amended by PL 2009, c. 16, §1, is further amended to read:
4 5 6 7 8	18. Transient occupancy. "Transient occupancy" means occupancy that does not exceed 120 days in a calendar year. For purposes of this subsection, for a tent, tent trailer, pickup camper, recreational vehicle, trailer or similar device used for camping, occupancy is determined by the length of time a person is present in the tent, trailer, camper, recreational vehicle or similar device.
9 10	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §685-C, sub-§12 is enacted to read: 12. Unaccupied compine devices. An unaccupied tent, tent trailer, pickup compar
10	12. Unoccupied camping devices. An unoccupied tent, tent trailer, pickup camper,
12	recreational vehicle, trailer or similar device used for camping may be stored at a campsite or campground in a space reserved for camping.
13	SUMMARY
14 15 16 17 18	This bill clarifies that occupancy in the definition of "transient occupancy" for the unorganized territories is determined by the length of time a person is present and allows the storage of unoccupied camping devices such as tents, tent trailers, pickup campers, recreational vehicles and trailers at campgrounds or campsites in reserved camping spaces.
