- 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
- 2 Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §760, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 348, §1, is amended to read:

## §760. Indemnification

3

4 A person is liable to the owner or operator of the overhead high-voltage line and 3rd 5 parties, if any, for all damages to facilities, injuries to persons and all costs, expenses and 6 liabilities incurred by the owner or operator of the overhead high-voltage lines and 3rd 7 parties, if any, as a result of any contact with an overhead high-voltage line if the person 8 causes, permits or allows any work or activity in violation of a provision of this chapter and, as a result, a physical or electrical contact with an overhead high-voltage line occurs, 9 10 except that if such damages, injuries and incurred costs, expenses and liabilities are caused by the combined fault of the person and the owner or operator of the overhead high-voltage 11 12 line, the liability of the person is joint and several with the owner or operator of the 13 overhead high-voltage line.

SUMMARY
This bill amends the Overhead High-voltage Line Safety Act to provide an exception
to indemnification by allowing for allocated liability if damages to facilities and injuries to
persons is caused by the combined fault of a person and the owner or operator of an
overhead high-voltage line.
