1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1811, sub-§3 is enacted to read:
3 4	3. Local option sales tax. A municipality may impose a local option sales tax on the sale of any good or service authorized to be taxed under this chapter by vote of the
5	legislative body of the municipality or by municipal referendum. The item to be voted on
6	must include language describing what the revenue from the tax is to be used for. A local
7	option sales tax under this subsection may be imposed on a seasonal or year-round basis.
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill allows a municipality to impose a seasonal or year-round local option sales
10	tax on the sale of any goods or services allowed to be taxed at the statewide level by vote
11	of the legislative body of the municipality or by municipal referendum.
