An Act To Increase Revenue for the ATV Recreational Management Fund

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §13155, sub-§5, as repealed and replaced by PL 2011, c. 116, §1 and affected by §2, is amended to read:
4	5. Fees. The ATV registration fee is:
5 6	A. For a resident, \$33 \underseps 38 annually. The registration for an ATV owned by a resident is valid for one year, beginning on July 1st of each year; and
7	B. For a nonresident:
8 9	(1) Fifty-three Fifty-eight dollars for a registration valid for 7 consecutive days. A person may purchase more than one 7-day registration in any season; and
10	(2) Sixty-eight Seventy-three dollars for a registration valid for one year.
11 12	The registration for an ATV owned by a nonresident must specify the dates for which the registration is valid.
13 14	Five dollars of each fee collected must be deposited in the ATV Recreational Management Fund as established in section 1893, subsection 2.
15	SUMMARY
16 17	This bill increases all-terrain vehicle registration fees by \$5, which increase must be deposited in the ATV Recreational Management Fund.
