1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1973, sub-§6 is enacted to read:
3	6. Use by disabled veterans. The authority shall waive tolls on the turnpike for a
4	veteran who meets the qualifications for a property tax exemption under Title 36, section
5	653 on the basis of a disability. The authority shall issue a windshield placard to a
6	veteran for whom tolls are waived under this subsection.
7	SUMMARY
8	This bill requires the Maine Turnpike Authority to waive tolls on the Maine Turnpike
9	for certain disabled Maine veterans.
