4 5 6	<b>2. Term.</b> "Term" means a full term <u>of office</u> or any portion of a term <u>that began during</u> the first regular session of the <u>Legislature</u> served by an elected official in an office subject to the provisions of this chapter.
7	Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect December 4, 2024.
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill amends the definition of "term" for the purposes of term limits for State
10	Senators and Representatives, the Secretary of State, the Treasurer of State, the Attorney
11	General and the State Auditor to specify that a full term begins in the first regular session
12	of the Legislature.
