1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §7484-B is enacted to read:
3	<u>§7484-B. Minimum award</u>
4 5 6	In any proceeding under this chapter in which the plaintiff prevails, the court shall order the defendant to pay not less than \$25 as a small claims award. The court may not suspend or waive the award.
7	SUMMARY
8 9	This bill amends the small claims laws to require the court to award a minimum of \$25 to a prevailing plaintiff. This award may not be suspended or waived by the court.
