A process for transmitting any driver's license number or nondriver identification 29 card number from an online voter registration application along with the applicant's 30 name and date of birth to the central voter registration system and for determining 31 whether the information entered in the central voter registration system matches the information in the driver's license or nondriver identification card records maintained 32 33 by the Department of the Secretary of State, Bureau of Motor Vehicles and, if a match 34 is found, for transmitting an electronic image of the applicant's signature on that driver's 35 license or nondriver identification card from the bureau to the central voter registration 36 system; 37 D.
