Other dental services, which may include preventive and restorative services and partial or full dentures, when the department determines that the other dental services are medically necessary to correct or ameliorate an underlying medical condition and will be cost-effective in comparison to the provision of other covered medical services for the treatment of that condition.
21	(1) By October 1, 2012 and quarterly thereafter, as limited by existing resources,
22	the department shall convene the MaineCare Dental Advisory Commission and
23	representatives of dental clinics, private dentists, MaineCare members and others
24	with expertise in medical and oral health to develop a list of underlying medical
25 26	conditions for which MaineCare dental services will be provided under this paragraph.
27	(2) The dental services must be available to MaineCare members without prior
28	authorization, must meet the requirements of this paragraph, must be identified
29	by a dentist or oral surgeon as dental services of short duration and must include
30	services that will reduce the need for care in a hospital emergency department or
31	reduce the need for other covered services.
32	(3) When the list under subparagraph (1) has been developed, the department
33	shall amend the rules of the MaineCare program to cover the listed services.

2	This amendment replaces the bill. It retains the provisions of the bill that seek to
3	provide cost-effective dental services for adult MaineCare members and adds a process
4	for identifying those services and a requirement that the services be cost-effective
