1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §802, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 507, §1, is amended to read:
4	1. Legislative service after December 2, 1986. All For a member who has 5 years
5	or more of creditable service on December 1, 2012, all legislative service of a the
6	member after December 2, 1986, for which contributions are made, shall be allowed as is
7	creditable service. For a member who has less than 5 years of creditable service on
8	December 1, 2012, all legislative service of the member after December 2, 1986 to
9	December 1, 2012 for which contributions are made is creditable service.
10	SUMMARY
11	This bill terminates creditable service under the Legislative Retirement Program for
12	members who have less than 5 years of creditable service on December 1, 2012.
