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## HOUSE AMENDMENT

Beginning July 1, 2012 and every July 1st thereafter, the 2 State Controller shall transfer to the STAR Transportation Fund an amount, as certified 3 by the State Tax Assessor, that is equivalent to 100% of the revenue from the tax imposed on the value of rental of a pickup truck or van with a gross weight of less than 26,000 4 pounds rented from a person primarily engaged in the business of renting automobiles 5 and the value of rental for a period of less than one year of an automobile pursuant to 6 Title 36, section 1811 for the first 6 months of the prior fiscal year. 16 **Sec. H-3. Effective date.** That section of this Part that amends the Maine Revised 17 Statutes, Title 23, section 4210-B, subsection 7 takes effect October 1, 2011. That 18 section of this Part that amends Title 23, section 4210-B, subsection 7-A takes effect June 19 30, 2012.'

## **SUMMARY**

This amendment corrects language relating to transfers of certain sales tax revenue to the State Transit, Aviation and Rail Transportation Fund to incorporate changes inadvertently omitted from Public Law 2011, chapter 209 and Public Law 2011, chapter 380, Part G.
