Maine Arts Commission to create a program for public art 21 **recovery grants.** Resolved: That the Maine Arts Commission shall create a program 22 to provide public art recovery grants. The sources of funds for the program are any funds 23 derived from the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 that are eligible for the purposes of the program. The purpose of the program is to provide grants to public entities 24 25 within the State, including, but not limited to, public postsecondary institutions, kindergarten to grade 12 schools, libraries, municipalities and state and local governmental 26 27 agencies that apply for funds for the installation of art or for the performance of art that is publicly accessible. For the purposes of the program, "art" must be construed broadly and 28 29 may include, but is not limited to, a mural, sculpture, painting, audio or visual presentation, 30 digital presentation, musical or theatrical performance, demonstration of or instruction in 31 an activity or performing a task or a lecture. A recipient of a grant under this section shall contract or commission a provider, maker or performer of the public art that resides or is 32 33 located in the State and is registered for the program with the Maine Arts Commission.' 34 Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or

2	This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, replaces the resolve.
3	The amendment directs the Maine Arts Commission to create a program to provide public
