4	D. The principal amount due at charge-off;
5	SUMMARY
6 7 8 9	This bill amends the law regarding the information that a debt buyer must possess for purposes of debt collection by clarifying that the debt buyer must possess not the principal amount due the original creditor at charge-off, when the creditor removed the debt from its books as an asset and began to treat it as a loss or expense because payment was unlikely, as in current law, but rather the total amount due at charge-off.
