SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and makes it a resolve. It implements a 13 14 recommendation of the Commission To Study Long-term Care Workforce Issues to increase reimbursement rates to direct care workers. The amendment requires the 15 Department of Health and Human Services to increase reimbursement rates to all direct 16 care worker services that are provided in home and community-based settings and in 17 institutional settings by no less than \$2 an hour. The amendment adds an emergency 18 preamble and emergency clause. The amendment also adds an appropriations and 19 allocations section. 20
