The joint standing committee may report out a bill to the First Regular Session of the 130th Legislature based on the board's recommendations.
- **Sec. 10. Board of Dental Practice to review licensing laws and recommend changes.** The Board of Dental Practice established by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 12004-A, subsection 10, in consultation with interested parties, shall review Title 32, chapter 143, any rules adopted by the board and any emerging issues identified by the board and recommend changes to update the licensing chapter and any rules or to address any emerging issues. The board shall submit its report and recommendations to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health coverage, insurance and financial services matters no later than February 15, 2021. The joint standing committee may report out a bill to the First Regular Session of the 130th Legislature based on the board's recommendations.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

This amendment adds language requiring each board to also consider emerging issues as part of the review of each board's licensing laws.
