1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1457-B is enacted to read:
3 4	<u>§1457-B.</u> Sale, consignment or distribution of motor fuel containing 10% or more <u>ethanol</u>
5 6	<u>A distributor, blender or retail dealer may not be required to sell, consign or distribute</u> motor fuel containing 10% or more ethanol.

8 9	This bill provides that a distributor, blender or retail dealer of motor fuel may not be required to sell, consign or distribute motor fuel containing 10% or more ethanol.
