1 2 3	1. It keeps the maximum eligibility level for family income under the Cub Care program at 200% of the federal poverty level, which is the amount established in current law.
4 5	It removes the provision that eligibility is not subject to an asset test because current rules do not make eligibility subject to an asset test.
6 7	3. It removes the requirement to provide coverage to persons 19 and 20 years of age and to noncitizens under 21 years of age.
8 9	4. It removes the requirement that the Department of Health and Human Services seek federal funds for outreach activities and removes the goal of outreach activities.
