.5	SUMMARY
6	This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, clarifies that Maine's
7	presidential electors are not obligated to cast their votes in favor of the presidential
8	candidate and vice presidential candidate that are declared the winners of the national
9	popular vote until the interstate compact to elect the President of the United States by national popular vote takes effect as described in the bill.
