The amendment strikes from the bill the definition of "public easement" and defines that term instead by reference to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 23, section 3021, subsection 2 and provides a definition of "emergency responder." The amendment provides an exception for an emergency responder that is similar to the exception in current law for a law enforcement officer.
