COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 536, L.D. 1626, Bill, “An Act To Clarify the Authority of the Department of Health and Human Services To Impose Administrative Sanctions upon Vendors, Providers and Participants in the Women, Infants and Children Special Supplemental Food Program”

Amend the bill in section 2 in §3107 in the first paragraph in the 3rd line from the end (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and 7 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 246.18" and inserting the following: '7 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 246.9 (2011), 7 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 246.18 (2011) and any other federal law that applies to adjudicatory proceedings for vendors, providers and participants'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment adds to the bill a citation to another section of the Code of Federal Regulations to ensure an opportunity for a hearing in making a determination that a vendor, provider or participant has violated a provision of the Women, Infants and Children Special Supplemental Food Program.
