15 This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, limits the amount that the Commissioner of Health and Human Services may pay a provider for medical 16 services provided to a resident of a state institution off the premises of the state institution 17 18 to the amount payable under insurance, including Medicare, for residents that have insurance; to the amount established by rule by the Department of Health and Human 19 Services under the MaineCare program, divided by 75% for physicians and hospitals 20 other than critical access hospitals; or to the MaineCare rate for all other providers. It 21 22 also adds an appropriations and allocations section to the bill.
