- 1 **Emergency preamble. Whereas,** acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
- 3 **Whereas,** the 2013 recodification of the Constitution of Maine has been completed 4 by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court and submitted to the Legislature; and
- 5 **Whereas,** the recodification must be made available to the public as soon as 6 possible and before the expiration of the 90-day period; and
- Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within
 the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as
 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
 therefore, be it
- 11 Sec. 1. Constitution; approval of 2013 draft and arrangement, 12 enrollment, distribution. Resolved: That the draft and arrangement of the 13 Constitution of Maine, as amended, made by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial 14 Court, pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article X, Section 6, is approved and that 15 the same be enrolled on parchment or other suitable material and deposited in the office 16 of the Secretary of State; and be it further
- 17 Sec. 2. Enrollment on durable material. Resolved: That the Secretary of 18 State is authorized and directed to cause the Constitution of Maine, as amended and 19 arranged, to be enrolled on parchment or other suitable material and upon final approval 20 of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court to attest to the correctness of that 21 enrollment under the seal of the State; and be it further
- Sec. 3. Publication. Resolved: That the Secretary of State is authorized and directed to cause to be published in pamphlet form, subject to the approval of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court, copies of the Constitution of Maine in such numbers as the Secretary of State determines necessary and that one copy of the pamphlet be forwarded to the municipal officers of each city and town and to the assessors of each plantation within the State.
- 28 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this 29 legislation takes effect when approved.

Maine as arranged by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court pursuant to the
Constitution of Maine, Article X, Section 6. The text of the Constitution of Maine as
