1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2140, sub-§13**, as enacted by PL 2019, c. 271, §4, is amended  
3 by enacting at the end a new first blocked paragraph to read:

4 The attending physician may waive any portion or all of the waiting periods if, in the  
5 attending physician's medical opinion, it is in the best interests of the qualified patient,  
6 given the qualified patient's condition.

7 **Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §2140, sub-§14, ¶F**, as enacted by PL 2019, c. 271, §4, is  
8 amended to read:

9 F. The attending physician's offer to the patient to rescind the patient's request at the  
10 time of the patient's 2nd oral request under subsection 11; ~~and~~

11 **Sec. 3. 22 MRSA §2140, sub-§14, ¶G**, as enacted by PL 2019, c. 271, §4, is  
12 amended to read:

13 G. A note by the attending physician indicating that all requirements under this Act  
14 have been met, including the requirements of subsection 6, and indicating the steps  
15 taken to carry out the patient's request, including a notation of the medication  
16 prescribed; and

17 **Sec. 4. 22 MRSA §2140, sub-§14, ¶H** is enacted to read:

18 H. When a portion or all of a waiting period under this section has been waived  
19 pursuant to subsection 13, a note by the attending physician that, in the attending  
20 physician's medical opinion, it is in the best interests of the qualified patient to waive  
21 a portion or all of the waiting period, given the qualified patient's condition, and what  
22 portion of the waiting period has been waived.

23 **SUMMARY**

24 This bill allows an attending physician to waive a portion or all of a waiting period for  
25 qualified patients to access end-of-life medication based on the qualified patient's condition  
26 and the attending physician's medical opinion regarding the best interests of the qualified  
27 patient.
