1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6073, sub-§2-A, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 876, §1, is repealed.
3 4	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6073, sub-§3, as amended by PL 2019, c. 113, Pt. C, §10, is further amended to read:
5 6 7 8 9	<b>3. Penalty.</b> Any <u>A</u> person who violates subsection 2-A or who knowingly and willfully violates subsection 2 is guilty of a Class D crime, except that, notwithstanding Title 17-A, sections 4-A, 1704 and 1705, the court shall impose a fine of not less than \$1,000 and restitution may be ordered made to the owner of the lease in an amount set by the court pursuant to Title 17-A, chapter 69.
10	Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §6863, as amended by PL 2013, c. 509, §10, is repealed.
