An Act to Require Vehicle Registrations to Include the Next of Kin of the Vehicle Owner

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §401, sub-§2, as amended by PL 2015, c. 473, §4, is further
amended to read:

4 2. Content of application. An application must contain information requested by the 5 Secretary of State, including the legal name, place of residence and address of the 6 registrant; the legal name and address of the next of kin of the registrant, if the registrant is an individual; the current mileage of a motor vehicle; a brief description of the vehicle, 7 8 the maker make of the motor vehicle, if needed, the vehicle identification number, the year 9 of manufacture, and the type of motor fuel or motive power; and, for trucks, truck tractors and special mobile equipment, the gross weight. A registrant that is a corporation, trust, 10 limited partnership or other similar entity must shall provide either a federal taxpayer 11 identification number or an identification number issued by the department. An initial 12 application for registration must be signed by the registrant or the registrant's legal 13 14 representative. The Secretary of State shall keep initial applications on file until that 15 registration is terminated.

Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §401, sub-§3, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2
and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

B. A certificate of registration that contains the <u>legal</u> name, place of residence and address of the registered owner <u>and the legal name and address of the next of kin of the</u>
registered owner as provided on the application.

SUMMARY

This bill adds to the required information requested by the Secretary of State on a vehicle registration application the requirement that a registrant, if an individual, include the legal name and address of the registrant's next of kin. The bill requires a vehicle certificate of registration to include the legal name and address of the vehicle owner's next of kin.
