An Act to Require School Board Approval of Superintendent Rules and Administrative Procedures

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §1001, sub-§1-A, as enacted by PL 2001, c. 588, §4, is
amended to read:

1-A. Adoption of policies. They shall adopt policies that govern the school administrative units and approve administrative procedures or rules established by the superintendent to implement policies under section 1055, subsection 13.

Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §1055, sub-§13 is enacted to read:

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8 13. Administrative procedures or rules. Upon the adoption of a new policy by the 9 school board, the superintendent shall establish administrative procedures or rules, as 10 appropriate, to implement the school board policy and submit the administrative procedures or rules to the school board for approval. No later than 7 days before the vote for approval 11 12 by the school board, the superintendent shall arrange for notice of the proposed 13 administrative procedures or rules in a newspaper having general circulation in the area of 14 the school administrative unit and publish the administrative procedures or rules on the school administrative unit's publicly accessible website. The administrative procedures or 15 16 rules may not become effective without the approval of the school board.

SUMMARY

18 This bill requires school superintendents to establish administrative procedures or rules 19 to implement school board policies. The proposed administrative procedures or rules must 20 be published in a local newspaper and published on a school administrative unit's publicly 21 accessible website at least 7 days prior to the school board vote on the administrative 22 procedures or rules. The administrative procedures or rules may not become effective 23 without the approval of the school board.
