"Qualified holder" or "holder" means a governmental entity authorized to hold an interest in real property, a holder as defined in section 476, subsection 2, paragraph B or a nonprofit organization organized under state law whose purposes include the permanent protection of working waterfront or the enlargement of working waterfront opportunities for commercial fisheries businesses.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill allows certain nonprofit corporations or charitable trusts that are authorized

to hold conservation easements to also be allowed to hold working waterfront covenants.

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
