1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6864, sub-§1-A,</b> as amended by PL 2013, c. 492, §15, is further amended to read:
4 5	<b>1-A. Limits on issuance <u>after February 1st</u>.</b> The department may not issue an elver dealer's license or a supplemental license after February 1st of the current licensing year.
6	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6864, sub-§1-B is enacted to read:
7 8 9 10	<b>1-B.</b> Limits on issuance to same person. The department may not issue an elver dealer's license or a supplemental license to a person using the same business address as a person who has violated section 6404-K, subsection 1 for at least 5 years following the violation.
11	SUMMARY
12 13 14 15	This bill amends the laws governing the licensing of elver dealers to provide that an elver dealer's license may not be issued to any person using the same business address as a person who has violated the conditions of the person's license for 5 years following the violation.
