The Secretary of State shall change the driving record of a holder 10 of a provisional license that is suspended under subsection 2 from indicating the suspension of the provisional license to indicating the motor vehicle violation committed that caused 11 12 the suspension upon restoration of the license. Sec. 3. 29-A MRSA §2472, sub-§8 is enacted to read: 13 8. Driving record. The Secretary of State shall change the driving record of a holder 14 of a provisional license that is suspended under subsection 2 from indicating the suspension 15 of the provisional license to indicating the motor vehicle violation committed that caused 16 the suspension upon restoration of the license under subsection 6. 17 18 SUMMARY 19 This bill requires the Secretary of State to change the driving record of a holder of a provisional license that is suspended for a motor vehicle violation from indicating the 20 suspension of the license to indicating the motor vehicle violation committed that caused 21 22 the suspension once the provisional license holder receives a permanent unrestricted license
- 23 or the provisional license is restored.
